

Hay Creek Township Monthly Meeting Minutes

August 6, 2025, at 6:00 PM

Zoom Meeting

Meeting Called to Order- 6:01 p.m. by Mary. Larry, Doug, Claudia, Brandy, and Scott were in attendance.

- I. Agreement on Agenda- Motion to approve by Larry and seconded by Doug. Unanimous. No changes.
- II. Minutes from July reviewed. Larry made a motion to approve minutes, seconded by Doug. Unanimous.
- III. Treasurer Reports
 - a. Bills Payable- Report by Brandy
 - b. Account Balance- Report by Brandy -Motion by Doug to accept financial statements, seconded by Larry. Unanimous.
- IV. Reports-
 - a. Assessments

- We have had 11 new building permits this past month.
- We have 78 properties with new or ongoing construction.
- We have 2670 parcels in Hay Creek.
- 130 miles driven
- 52 hours worked

b. Roads-

- Update on gravel and chip seal projects and patching. All the graveling has been completed. The quality of the gravel is not as desirable. The chip seal project in Ashwood is nearing completion. The road is much improved.
- Rooster Road blow-out is not yet repaired, but it's on the list to be completed.
- For state grant consideration all townships need to be at 18 mills. We are not at and have no plans to be at 18 mills, but Mary will contact the DOT to discuss if there are other potential grants that we would qualify.
- Larry visited with Dan Schriock today and changes have been made to the road maps- online, this change has been made online. Any constituent with concerns about overloaded trucks on residential roads with the new weight restrictions could contact the sheriff's office and have scales deployed to the area to weigh the trucks.

c. Constituent Calls/Reports-

- Email from a resident in Ponderosa Village requesting dust control. The dilemma with this is the poor quality of the gravel and how slippery the road gets when it's wet and the dust control exacerbates this problem; the township preference is not using dust control unless necessary.

d. Planning and Zoning Committee Report, MPO, Water Board updates.

- V. Unfinished Business- Consideration to continue dust control chloride by the Pumpkin Patch. SAD for North Ridge- residents should have all received this packet of information by now. There will be a public hearing on September 3, 2025, at 5:00 PM. The cost per lot would be \$4,663. Total cost of the project would be \$668,533.91 with the township putting in a share of \$127,000.
